Our overall school attendance for last half term was 98.0%



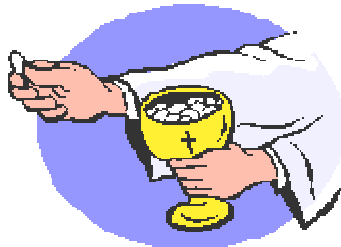
The individual class winners for the attendance awards were as follows:
