Remote Learning Policy - Pupil Policy

In the event of school closure, the School will continue your education through a programme of remote learning, utilising the technology that is available and, where possible, familiar to both pupils and teachers. The aim of this policy is to outline how remote learning will work on a day-to-day basis and give you specific guidelines as to how you should use this technology in a safe and responsible way. As a parent, please read the below information and agree to the terms in the User Agreement for your child.

The daily routine

It is important that you try and keep to a daily structure to help you keep on top of your activities. Therefore, as much as possible, you should try and follow the timetable provided each week by your designated teacher.

As part of the remote learning programme, work will only be set for pupils between 8am and 3.20pm from Monday to Friday.

How will lessons work?

Your teacher will set you activities each week via Class DOJO and/or Google Classroom. The activities are delivered through common teaching resources e.g Powerpoint or videos with explanations and instructions from your teacher. Some of the activities will need to be done on the an electronic device and others will need you to complete them independently using different materials as shown. Your teachers will mark and give you feedback on your work where appropriate, once you upload a picture of your work to your portfolio.

In addition, your teachers may request a 'virtual check-in' with you via Google Meet so that you can have face-to-face contact with them and your class.

There will be a 'Star of the Week' video each week to celebrate what you have been doing, each teacher will choose a star from their class. In addition, DOJO points will be awarded for each particular activity that the child completes. The teacher will announce the top 3 DOJO point winners each week.
